



YMCA GUEST POLICY

Effective March 3, 2010

ADULT MEMBERSHIP HOLDERS!!!

The YMCA encourages its adult members to be ambassadors in the community to help cultivate new members interested in joining. To that end, adult membership holders will receive three complimentary adult guest passes each year, which must be used by three separate adult guests. Thereafter, each adult guest may visit the YMCA two additional times in a calendar year by purchasing an adult guest pass. If the adult guest would like to continue to use the YMCA, then a membership is required.

YMCA Adult Members may only bring one guest at a time.

Local Guests

Local guests are those individuals and families who reside in the Beckley-Raleigh County YMCA's service area. All local guests must be accompanied by a YMCA adult member and may visit the Y up to three times in a calendar year. Additional visits will require the purchase of a membership. Local guests must complete the Guest Registration Process and sign the Guest Waiver before entry is granted. Once entry is granted, guests must adhere to the YMCA's Code of Conduct and all Policies & Procedures. The following applies to our local guests:

- Guests 16 or older must present a valid driver's license.
- Guests 18 or younger must be accompanied by an adult member for the duration of their visit.
- Guests 12 or younger must have the adult member complete the Guest Waiver for the youth to be admitted.

Cost for Guest Passes

Guest pass purchases are good for the day of purchase only.

Family Guest Passes: \$15

Adult Guest Passes: \$10

Teen (13-18) Guest Passes: \$8

Youth (12 & Under) Guest Passes: \$5

Out of Town Guests

Out of town guests are those adult individuals and families who reside outside (50 miles or more) of the Beckley-Raleigh County YMCA's service area. Out of town guests may use the Y up to three times in a calendar year. Out of town guests may use the YMCA by purchasing a guest pass, presenting a valid driver's license, completing the Guest Registration Process and signing the Guest Waiver. Once entry is granted, the YMCA's Code of Conduct and all Policies & Procedures apply. Please note:

- Out of town guests staying in the area for a month or more may contact the YMCA to arrange for a temporary membership by calling (304) 252-0715 ext. 322.
- YMCA Adult Members with out of town guests visiting for the holidays or other special occasions may accompany them to the YMCA for a complimentary guest visit.

AWAY Program

AWAY (Always Welcome at YMCAs) Guests are permitted to use the YMCA without a guest pass purchase. AWAY Guests must present a valid YMCA membership card and driver's license to the Welcome Center Desk and sign the Guest Waiver.
